Open District Committee Positions:

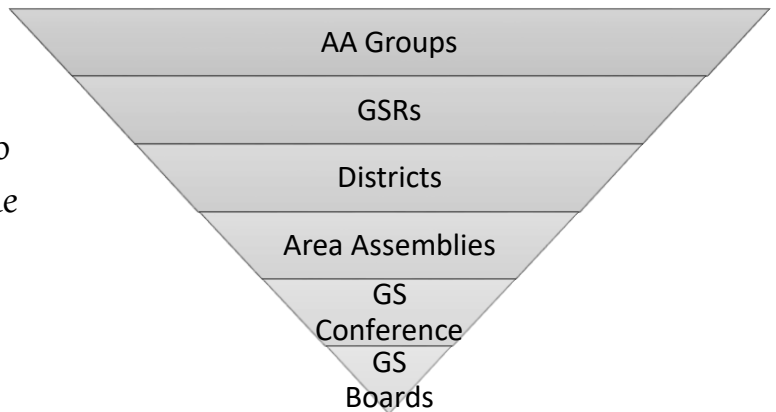
Hill Country Intergroup Rep- contact person that acts like a liaison between groups in District 29 and Hill Country Intergroup.
